



Camping Rules :

Registration for camping begins Thursday before the Festival Starts, Please check in at the designated Camping Gate.

3-Day passes for the festival are \$10 per person, and are required to be on the grounds during the festival.

All tents and equipment must be located in the assigned lot.

Only 1 vehicle is permitted with camping registration, additional parking passes are available at the designated camping gate at a cost of \$20. Free parking is available in the main parking lot.

Cleanliness :

Please make sure your site is cleaned of all material before you leave. Please leave it in as good or better condition than it was when you arrived. If you have an issue with conditions upon arrival let the Camp Host or gate attendant know, accommodations will be made in every attempt.

If you have a pet traveling with you, please remove all waste appropriately before you leave.

Campfires :

Grills and small contained fires are permissible. Fires must be contained and above ground in an approved container (fire pit) no larger than 30" in diameter. All containers must be removed when leaving at the end of the weekend. Open non-contained campfires will not be permitted and must be put out immediately.

Do Not transport firewood across state lines due to the Emerald Ash Borer infestations. If you have questions on this please see www.emeraldashborer.info .

Do Not remove any standing or down trees, limbs or brush (dead or alive) from the festival property for firewood.

Pets :

All pets must remain in your assigned campsite, and leashed at all times. No pets will be permitted outside of the camping areas.

Please remove all pet litter, food or manure when you vacate your campsite.

Campground Courtesy :

Quiet hours are observed from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m., please respect your neighbors.

The Speed Limit on all camp roads is 5 MPH, speeding will not be tolerated.

The following will be cause for immediate expulsion from the property with no refunds.

1. Firearms and fireworks
2. Alcohol and illegal drugs
3. Public nudity
