FLAT ROCK CAMPING RULES

TO MAKE YOUR VISIT AT THIS CAMPGROUND ENJOYABLE

Occupying your campsite

- Registration for Camping begins Thursday, September 14, 2017 at 9:00 AM at the Camping Gate.
 Please check in there.
- Passes for the fall festival are \$10 per person for the three day event. Wristbands will be required for all of those on the grounds.
- Please be patient as our Staff of Volunteers assist you in finding a camp sites.
- All tents and equipment must be located within the designated site.
- Only one vehicle is allowed in addition to your camping unit because of limited space. Free parking is available. If you wish to park two vehicles on your site, you are required to pay a \$20.00 parking fee for the weekend.

Follow Standard Procedure

- Clean your site: Think of the old Scout motto and always leave the area as good as or better than when you arrived!
- Always attend your fire: Because you can endanger those around you, this is one of the most important camping rules, regardless of where you go. Be sure to put out your fire before bed, before heading out for the day, or when you leave the site at the end of your stay. The general rule of thumb is to make sure the coals or ashes are cold.
- Clean up after your pets.

Campfires

- Grills and small contained fires are permissible. Fires must be contained and above ground in an approved container (fire pit) no larger than 30" in diameter. Grills and fire containers must be removed after the event weekend. Due to the large number of guests and the close proximity of the campers, we cannot permit open non-contained campfires.
- GROUND FIRES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.
- Use only dead and down trees for firewood. Do not cut live trees.
- Do NOT transport firewood over state lines due to the Emerald Ash Borer infestation. If you have questions, please see http://www.emeraldashborer.info/

Controlling your pets

- Leash your pets at all times.
- Keep your pet within your designated campsite. NO ANIMALS WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE OF THE CAMPING AREAS.
- Please remove pet litter, food or manure when you vacate your campsite.

Campground courtesy

- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Drive cautiously on campground roads and observe posted speed limits.
- Obey the law. The following are prohibited here and will result in immediate expulsion from the grounds:
 - o Firearms and fireworks
 - Alcohol and illegal drugs
 - o Public nudity

Liability

- Camper will maintain the site in a reasonably clean condition

Refunds

• In order to qualify for a refund, cancellation requests must be received in our office in writing no later than August 1. Refund checks will be processed within 30 days after the closing date of the event. There will be no refunds given for cancellations after August 1.
